



Dual Degree Program

A unique opportunity to earn two degrees by transferring credits from your home institution's MBA program to Florida International University's Master of International Business (MIB) program.

FIU's Master of International Business is a specialized program that focuses on the key skills, behaviors and techniques required for you to succeed in the international marketplace.

What are the benefits?

- Earn two degrees in almost the same time that it would take to obtain one: an MBA from your home University and an MIB from FIU's Chapman Graduate School – one of the leading business schools in the field of international business.
- Stay for up to twelve months of Optional Practical Training in the U.S. upon completion of the MIB.
- Access FIU's Career Management Services office.
- Establish two networks of classmates and peers – one in your country and one in the U.S. – an invaluable asset for your career and business development.

How does it work?

- FIU accepts 12 credit hours for courses completed in your MBA program.
- During 2 consecutive semesters at FIU, you take 24 credit hours:
 - 2 workshops (Accounting and Data Analysis)
 - 1 seminar course (3 credit hours)
 - 6 core courses (3 credit hours each)
 - Master's Project in International Business (3 credit hours)
- You need to maintain a GPA of 3.0/4.0 in the courses taken at FIU.

What are the admission requirements?

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution.
- Minimum 3.0/4.0 grade point average or better on upper division coursework.
- Official transcripts of both your undergraduate and MBA courses. Transcripts must come in a sealed envelope of the university. Official translations must also be submitted if transcripts are not in English.
- Score a minimum of 550 on the paper-based TOEFL, 213 on the computer-based TOEFL, 80 on the internet-based TOEFL, or 6.5 on the IELTS exam.
- Letter of recommendation from the Director of your MBA program.
- Resume

**Other requirements may apply as per specific Dual Degree agreements.*

How much does it cost?

- The cost of the MIB for a Dual Degree student is approximately US\$16,000 (tuition only) for the academic year 2009-2010.
